Following the success of Tasman School's first Art Auction which was held in conjunction with the Tasman School Centenary Celebrations in 2013, we warmly invite you to submit up to two artworks for the 2015 Biennial Art Auction, which will take place on Saturday October 31st at 4pm.

We were overwhelmed by the generosity of donations in 2013 and the turnout for the Art Auction and consequent sales. Our experienced auctioneer sold 45 artworks ranging in price from \$50 - \$1600 that included a wide range of media. This has proven to be a win-win event for all. It is an opportunity for your artwork to reach a wider audience, and provide Tasman School with the funds to foster and enrich students learning and appreciation of the arts.

We are a small rural school surrounded on one side by orchards and award-winning vineyards, and the beautiful Kina coastline and Moutere Inlet on the other. We are committed to building an arts rich culture and hope to continue to provide opportunities for students to appreciate, challenge and create. Along with several Artist in Residence programmes, last year Tasman School participated in the 2014 Masked Parade in Nelson which is a highlight of the Festival of the Arts, winning the overall Supreme Award with our Steampunk inspired theme!

There will be a few changes to the format of this year's auction. Instead of an exhibition, an online catalogue will be available one month prior to the auction. The minimum donation for all artwork is 30% of the sale price up to a full donation of 100% to Tasman School. In order to submit an artwork for approval, we ask that you fully complete the registration form and return it to the address provided, along with a high quality digital image of the piece/s that you wish to donate by 20th September.

To keep the standard high for this event we ask that you submit a quality original artwork that reflects your current artistic direction. Please ensure that all wall-hung pieces are mounted, framed, and presented ready for display with instructions provided if necessary. Please include a short biography about yourself and your artwork. This will enable us to make sure we represent you and your artwork in a professional manner in the catalogue, and in all promotional material. Once your completed registration is received and approved you will be notified and arrangements will be made in regards to collection or delivery of the artwork.

We invite all artists to attend an opening evening on Friday 30th October 5pm - 7pm at Tasman School.
