FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Kia ora koutou,

Next week we will still be running a similar format for entry onto the school grounds beyond the carpark. Thank you for your continued patience and support of this process.

Last week I forgot to thank everyone for returning our school resources so swiftly, and in the condition they left our school in. This was what I expected and part of the reason why we were so comfortable handing out devices on request during 'lockdown'.

Could all swimming pool keys please be returned. We need these keys returned to avoid lock changing. To keep the key hire fee reasonable, we need to avoid this cost. At present the running of the swimming pool is heavily reliant on volunteer time. Thank you to those parents that did periods of testing over the summer break and weekends. Special thanks needs to go to Damian Campbell, Nathan Ellis and Kate Lovell (non-parent) for the considerable volunteer time that they have put into ensuring that the swimming pool was available for out of school hours use.

As we have had a number of new families join us, it is a good time to introduce and remind existing families of the processes in our school. Our process is as follows:

1. Issues should be directed to the staff member involved. In most cases this will be the classroom teacher and this is the best person to problem-solve as they are working in the classroom on a day to day basis with your child. In some cases you need to encourage your child to speak to the teacher or support your child speaking to the teacher, particularly in the Senior Syndicate. This sort of experience helps to build resilience and independence in students.
2. If the issue is not resolved contact should be made with the Syndicate Leader. The Syndicate Leader will support and offer further guidance if school processes have not been followed:
 - Senior Syndicate (Kereru, Weka, Ruru) - jon@tasman.school.nz

1. If the issue is not resolved contact should be made with the Principal and a meeting request can be made via email stating the purpose of the meeting. The Principal will support and offer further guidance if school processes have not been followed - rob@tasman.school.nz

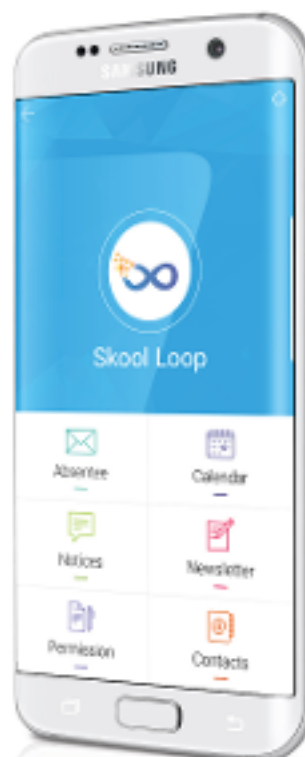
