## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Kia ora koutou,

The Board of Trustees have opted to fund a part-time teacher in Room 1 to support roll growth at the start of Term 4. Vi Hikuroa has agreed to fill these hours for Term 4

Vi will work on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9:30 am until 12:30 pm. She will also continue to do the full day on a Friday.

Thinking ahead for future years, we'd really appreciate knowing of students who are likely to come to Tasman School. Jude has strong connections with local Early Childhood Education centres, but we are having a number of people enquire about the school and the names haven't been raised through this process - possibly through being new to the area or not attending the centres through which we have existing connections. If you have a neighbour, friend or relative with children that are intending to attend Tasman School please encourage them to make contact with us, if they haven't already done so. Having the actual names of children helps us to make more accurate predictions for rolls each year and also helps us to contest Ministry of Education funding. We are currently in discussions with the Ministry regarding our lack of building space and evidence of a roll that is continuing to grow will definitely strengthen our case.

We have received further good news of a \$3,000 grant from the Tasman District Council to assist in the building of our changing shed block. Yesterday the Tasman District Council indicated via email that consent has been granted pending final payment of fees. We are now just awaiting the final documentation to proceed with the building aspect of the project.
